**RULES REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS OF THE OFFICE  
BEARERS OF THE COLLEGE OF VOCATIONAL STUDIES STUDENTS'  
UNION FOR THE YEAR 2023-2024**

Following rules, terms, conditions and "Code of Conduct" issued by the University of Delhi will be strictly adhered for contesting the Students' Union election of the College.

1. Only **3<sup>rd</sup> year** students shall be eligible to contest for the post of President.
2. The post of Joint Secretary is open only to **1<sup>st</sup> year** students.
3. Candidates must have obtained **50% marks** in the last examination i.e. the examination held immediately before contesting the election. However the 50% marks criteria will **not** be applicable for the post of Central Councilor (CC) as these are as per DUSU Rules/Constitution. The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election.
4. The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the university or **75 percent attendance**, whichever is higher.
5. The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office-bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of an executive member.
6. The candidate shall not have a previous criminal record, that is to say he should not have been tried and / or convicted of any criminal offence or misdemeanour. The candidate shall also not have been subject to any disciplinary action by the university authorities.
7. The candidate must be a regular, full-time student of the College/University and should not be a distance/proximate education student. That is to say that all eligible candidates must be enrolled in a full-time course, the course duration being at least one year.
8. Candidates for the post of President are required to deposit Rs. 200/- as security (Refundable). Candidates for all other posts are required to deposit Rs. 100/- as security.
9. The Security deposit shall be forfeited in case a candidate fails to get at least 10% of the total valid votes cast for the post.
10. A candidate withdrawing his/her candidature before the last date fixed for such withdrawal may claim the return of security deposit in person by showing his/her identity card from Mr. Manoj Kumar Sharma, A.O. (Admn.) Room No. 6.
